The youth worker will be working mostly with the fisheries crew from a boat on designated lakes and ponds setting or pulling traps but will also get to work in many other areas of land and wildlife conservation projects and maintenance of recreational areas.

This is a great opportunity for youth that are interested in exploring careers in the Natural Resource field.


Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assist with fish population surveys.
- Assist with a variety of wildlife surveys.
- Assist with maintenance of apple orchard and native plant restoration plots.
- Assist with harvesting fathead minnows for forage demand.
- Assist with building and grounds maintenance at designated locations.
- Assist with field inspections for land lease compliance.

Qualification Requirements:

- Must be between the ages 17 to 22 and have an interest in pursuing a natural resource career.
- Must be able to work from a boat and wear required flotation vests.
- Must be able to operate various types of maintenance equipment such as mowers and weed eaters.
- Must be able to work outdoors performing physical labor in adverse weather conditions.
