Job Title: Fencing Laborer

Reports to: Fish & Wildlife Manager

Duration: Seasonal

Summary:

Fencing laborers are employees of the SWO and will be under the supervision of the SWO Fish & Wildlife Manager or the F&W Field Supervisor. The fencing laborer will be assigned to various land conservation and/or restoration projects.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Will construct, repair and maintain fences for livestock, including installing posts, wire and gates.
- Will operate various equipment such as tractors, skid steer, lawn mowers, chainsaw, etc.
- Will be actively involved in the implementation of restoration projects, including hand planting and hand seed collection.
- Will be involved in site preparation, seeding, fertilizing, and mulching in designated areas.
- Will be involved in general land maintenance such as weed control efforts by mowing or manual removal.
- Other duties may be assigned by supervisor for other projects within the Fish & Wildlife department.

Qualification Requirements:

- Must be physically fit-walking, bending, climbing off and on equipment and lifting up to 50 #s.
- Must have a driver's license and be eligible to obtain a tribal driver's license.
- Working outside in all types of weather conditions.
- Must be able to pass a drug test and be randomly tested.
- Tribal preference will apply.
