Job Title: SWO - Home Health Care Workers (4)

Reports to: LPN/Home Health Care Program and the Director of Elderly Affairs Program

Responsibilities:

- 1. Daily supervision shall be provided by the LPN regarding Home Health Care Issues of the elderly/physical handicapped clients which are to be served on a daily and monthly basis.
- 2. Daily chores/cleaning of homes/apartments, bathrooms clean refrigerators if needed, dusting, clean stoves and any general cleaning. Help with personal hygiene-such as bathing, doing laundry.
- 3. Should be able to do some lifting.
- 4. HHCW's must keep a daily log on the individuals that were seen and reports to supervisor on any concerns that the individuals may have or seen/any elder abuse. Must keep a mileage Daily log.
- 5. HHCW- cleans for the elderly that are homebound/physical handicapped individuals that cannot help themselves. Most elderly live alone and HCW will clean only for these individuals.

QUALIFICATION:

- 1. Must have own transportation, driver's license and insurance.
- 2. Must have a home phone or a cell.
- 3. Some record-keeping experience
- 4. May be a certified nurse's aide or had experience as one
- 5. Familiarity with the Indian elderly/physically handicapped participants and this MUST done is a respectful and courteous manner.
- 6. Understanding of the culture and the lifestyles of Dakota Indian people.
- 7. Indian preference in hiring is observed.
- 8. High school or GED
- 9. CONFIDENTIALITY IS A MUST.
