ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DISMISS NOTICE OF APPEAL

Per curium (Chief Justice Thor A. Hoyte, Associate Justice Russell Zephier, Associate Justice Pat Donovan)

In the matter of the appeal of White versus the Reservation Election Board, the Sisseton-Wahpeton Supreme Court has received briefing and a Motion to Dismiss Notice of Appeal. The Court has reviewed the material and finds the following:

- 1) Sisseton-Wahpeton Oyate Election Code Sec. 03-05-10 states, in part, "[t]he Tribal Court's determination of the appeal shall be final and NO APPEAL may lie to the Northern Plains Intertribal Court of Appeals or any other appellate court of the Tribe."
- 2) The Court understands a "special election", for purposes of the election code and its appeal procedure, is no different from that of a regular "election".
- 3) All other challenges made under the Sisseton-Wahpeton Oyate Revised Constitution and By-Laws and Bill of Rights are without merit as the

constitutionality of the Election Code has not been challenged, and thus is controlling as a reasonable enactment of law under the Constitution.
